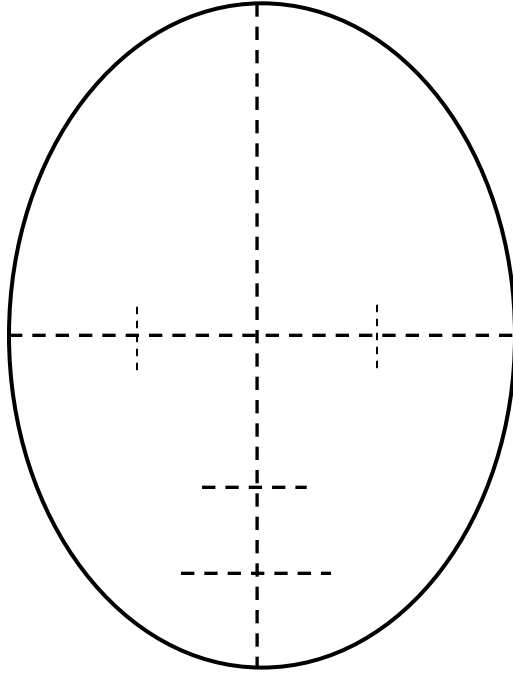


In order to paint such realistic portraits, Leonardo da Vinci had to study the features of the face. Follow the directions and you will learn some of his secrets.



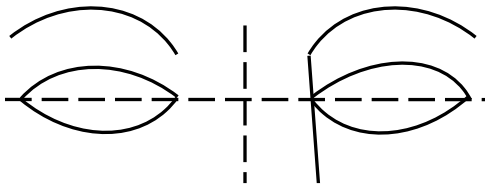
Lightly sketch a guide line straight down the center of the oval shape in the frame below.

Divide it in half for the eye line.

Divide it in half again for the bottom of the nose line.

Divide it in half one more time for the mouth line.

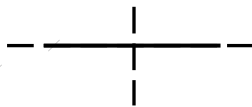
Draw eyes centered on the eye line.



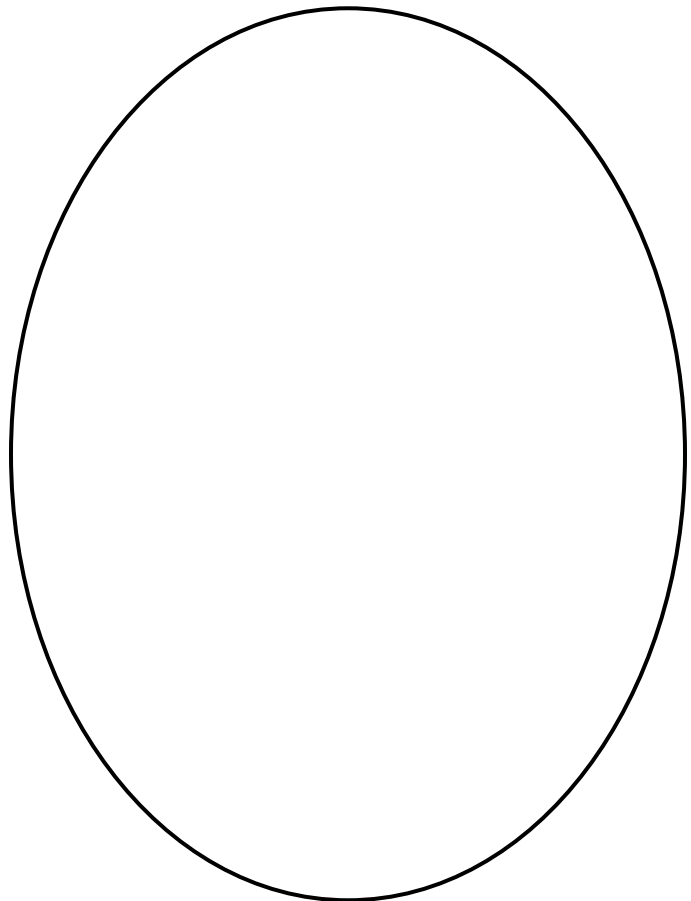
Draw a straight line from the brow line to the nose line.



And, draw a short line to form the bottom of the nose.



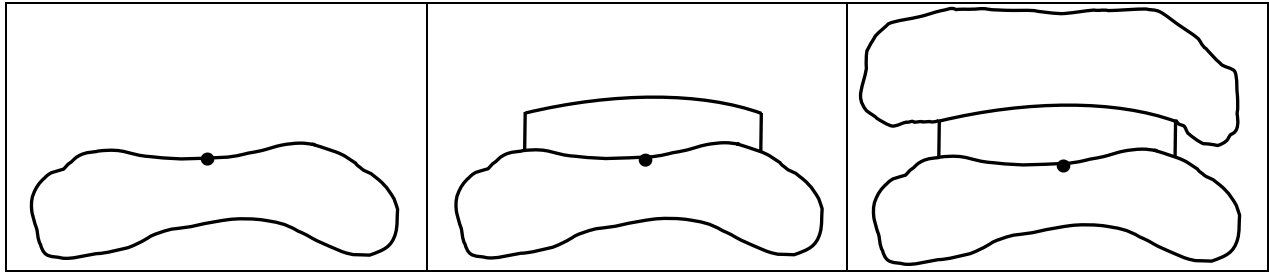
Draw a line for the mouth on the mouth line.



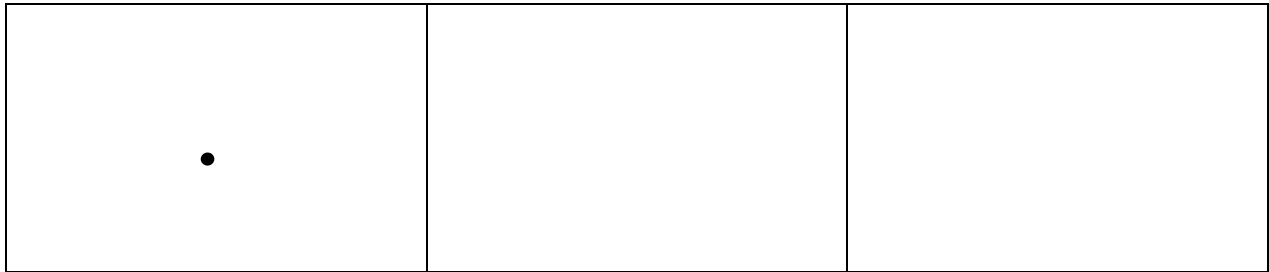
Drawing Renaissance Hats.

Men wore hats, not only for fashion, but also for warmth.



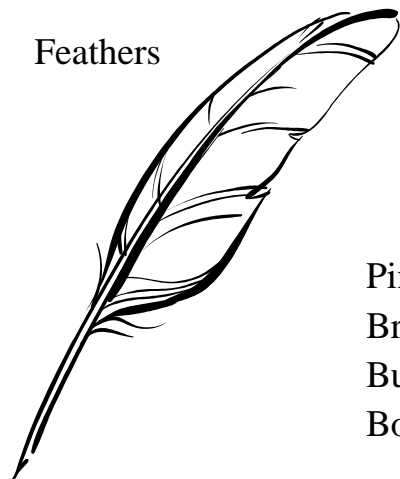
Copy these easy steps in drawing a Renaissance man's hat.



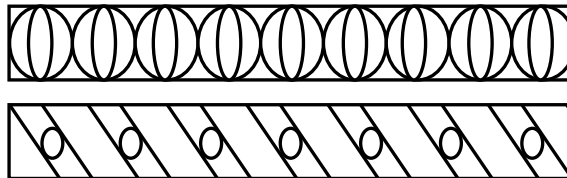
Start at the dot.
